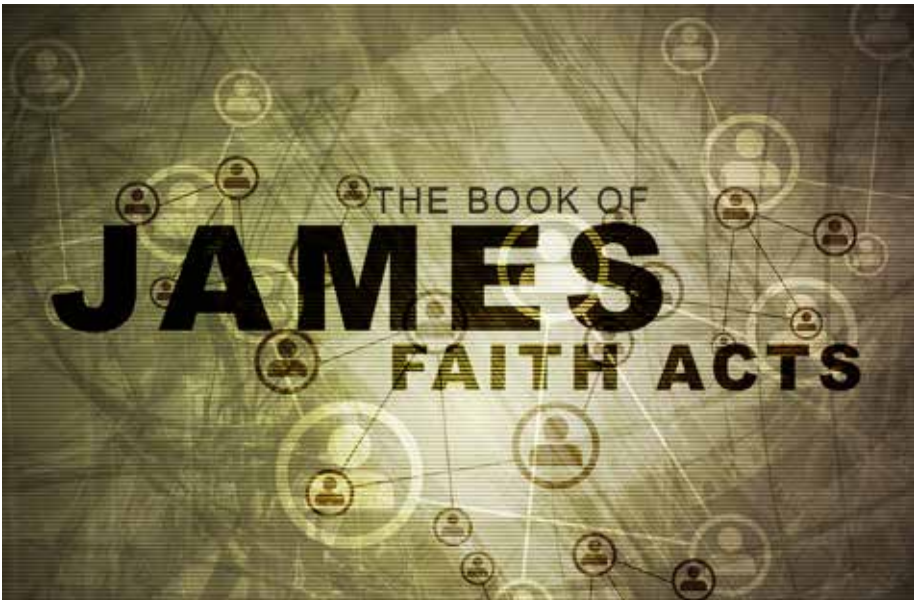

TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

John Chapter 15

Context: Setting the Table

After introducing the witnesses to Jesus in chapter one, John recorded the public ministry of Jesus in chapters two through eleven. Chapter twelve summarizes Christ's public ministry and marks the coming of his long-awaited "hour." This fifteenth chapter continues Jesus's farewell discourse from chapters thirteen and fourteen. As time of his own departure came ever nearer, Jesus remained focused on the preparation of his disciples.

Content: Hearing the Text

Read John 15 together out loud.

Credo: Believing the Truth

Although the time for Jesus and his disciples to arise and go had already come, there was so much more he had to say. The truths they needed so desperately then, we need no less in our own day. Jesus is the only true Vine, the true and perfect fulfillment of all that Old Testament Israel should have accomplished but never did. All and only those who abide in him will bear the true fruit of obedient and joy-producing love. All who belong to Jesus will experience the hatred the world first directed toward their Master, for the work of the Spirit will enable them to bear witness of him in the same way that he bore witness to the Father.

Conduct: Reshaping Our Walk

Discuss the meaning of the text and then walk through the following application questions as you discuss the difference this meaning ought to make in our lives today.

How are we tempted to seek joy apart from obedience?

What are some ways in which we escape the hatred of the world by failing to reflect the message and mission of Christ in one area or another?

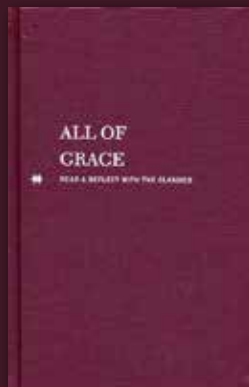
