TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

Genesis 25:1–25:34

Context: Setting the Table

After its initial creational prologue, Genesis divides into two unequal halves of five sections each. The first half of the book (2:4–11:26) deals with the history of humanity as a whole, from its creation to the birth of Abram. The second half of the book (11:27–50:26) focuses on the history of the patriarchs. In this chapter, we find the conclusion of the story of Abraham, the brief family history of Ishmael, and the beginning of the family history of Isaac.

Content: Hearing the Text

Read Genesis 25:1–25:34 together out loud.

Credo: Believing the Truth

After 100 years of walking with God, Abraham's life came to a peaceful conclusion. Though Ishmael was not the son of promise, God fulfilled his promises to him fully. Yet the greater blessings that Isaac received came with difficulties of their own. While his marriage to Rebekah must have seemed like a "match made in heaven," it was followed by 20 years of infertility. When his wife finally conceived, her pregnancy was horrifically painful. When the twins grew up, their deep character flaws resulted in constant conflict. Despite all of these difficulties, God's promises remained secure and his plan—to rescue the world through the offspring of Abraham—remained unchanged.

Conduct: Reshaping Our Walk

Though Rebekah's marriage was clearly the result of divine guidance, it was followed by 20 years of infertility. How might we be tempted to doubt the wisdom of God's plans when they involve more suffering than we had expected?

Examples: Wondering if we married "the one" when our marriage involves more difficulties than we expected; Regretting generosity when it seems to be followed by hardship rather than the particular blessings we anticipated.

What are some of the ways in which we could be tempted to undervalue or even despise the gifts that God has given to us?

Examples: Young people ignoring the boundaries their parents have set in place to protect them; Taking little care for the possessions God has blessed us with because they aren't the ones we would have chosen.

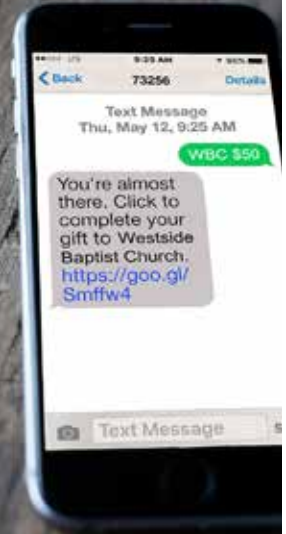

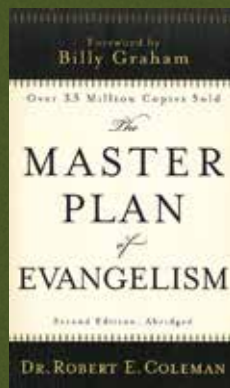
