# TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

## Genesis 28:10–28:22

### *Context: Setting the Table*

After laying a creational foundation, Genesis divides into two unequal halves of five sections each. The first half of the book (2:4–11:26) deals with the history of humanity as a whole, from its creation to the birth of Abram. The second half of the book (11:27–50:26) focuses on the history of the patriarchs. In this section, God meets the fleeing Jacob in an unexpected dream.

### *Content: Hearing the Text*

Read Genesis 28:10–28:22 together out loud.

### *Credo: Believing the Truth*

Although Jacob's trickery had won him both birthright and blessing, neither could protect him from the murderous rage of his brother. Forced to leave home with little more than the clothes on his back, he began the long and treacherous journey from Beer-Sheba to Haran alone and on foot. Yet though neither Jacob nor Esau seem to have been even slightly concerned about God, God had by no means forgotten about his promise to bless the world through the offspring of Abraham. With startling suddenness, God appeared to Jacob in a dream, promising his presence and reminding him that the blessing of God could not and would not be limited to material prosperity alone.

### *Conduct: Reshaping Our Walk*

Although God abundantly fulfilled his promise to be "with" Jacob, this by no means spared him from the just consequences of his actions. How might we be tempted to treat God's promise of presence like a "get out of jail free card"?

*Examples:* Becoming frustrated or even angry with God when our own sin or folly creates suffering in our lives; Taking sin lightly because we falsely assume that its consequences will disappear as soon as we ask for forgiveness.

Although Jacob was willing to do almost anything to get the blessing, God's plan was for him to be a blessing. What are some practical steps we can take to orient our lives around the blessings we ought to become rather than the blessings we hope to receive?

*Examples:* The way we spend our money; the way we schedule our time; the goals we set for our lives.
