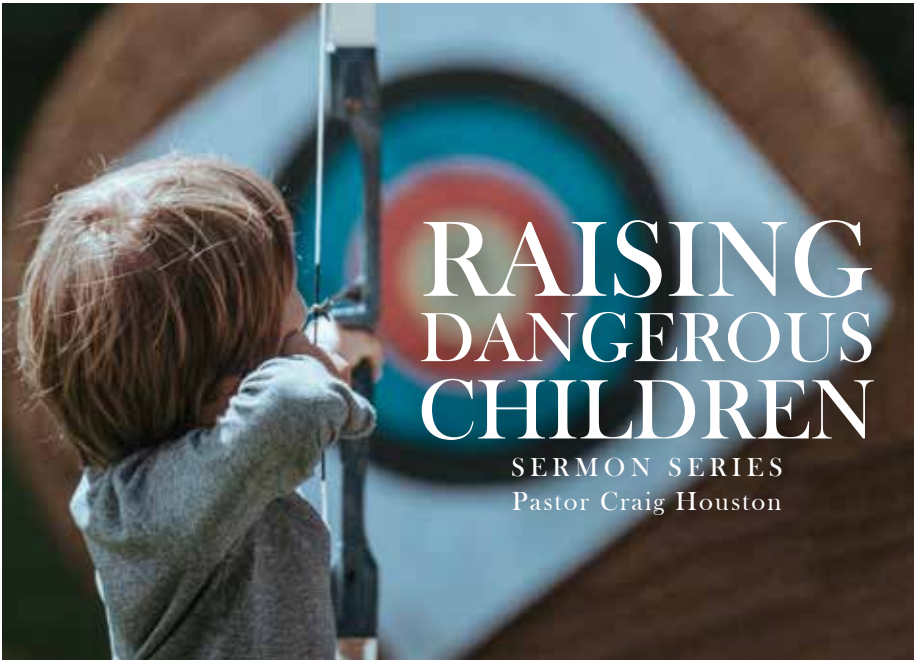

TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

Genesis 31:22–32:2

Context: Setting the Table

After a creational prologue, Genesis divides into two unequal halves of five sections each. The first half of the book (2:4–11:26) deals with the history of humanity as a whole, from its creation to the birth of Abram. The second half of the book (11:27–50:26) focuses on the history of the patriarchs. In this section, Jacob persuades his wives to flee Haran and is protected by God from Laban's pursuit.

Content: Hearing the Text

Read Genesis 31:22–32:2 together out loud.

Credo: Believing the Truth

In response to Jacob's unexpected success at stockbreeding, Laban simply used his position of power to arbitrarily and repeatedly change the terms of their agreement. Yet though Laban's treachery may have been more than a match for Jacob's diligence and cleverness, he couldn't even begin to compete with the power of Jacob's God. When Jacob, in obedience to a divine command, finally made his escape from Haran, he was miraculously protected from his pursuing uncle. To the God whose promises could not be thwarted by even the unworthiness of a Jacob, the blusterings of a Laban posed not the slightest of obstacles.

Conduct: Reshaping Our Walk

Though Jacob was "in the right" and Laban was "in the wrong," Jacob's confidence that Laban was lying about his stolen idols was nevertheless dangerously misplaced. How might we be tempted to presume that those who oppose us wrongfully are therefore wrong about everything?

Examples: Being so confident in the correctness of our doctrinal, political, and social views that we are no longer willing to listen to anyone, etc.

Though Laban seemed to himself and others to be a formidable and dangerous enemy, by the time God was done exposing him, Laban the frightening thug was revealed to be both powerless and out of touch with reality. How might we be tempted to take our opponents more seriously than God takes them?

Examples: Allowing our fear of those who oppose us to overwhelm our confidence in our God.

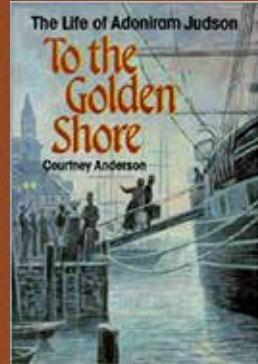

Drawing on letters and church records, Courtney Anderson paints a poignant portrait of Judson's early life in dealing with the conflict between his desire for material success and the inner call to serve God.
