TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

Genesis 35:1–35:29

Context: Setting the Table

Following its magnificent introduction, Genesis divides into two unequal halves of five sections each. The first half of the book (2:4–11:26) deals with the history of humanity as a whole, from its creation to the birth of Abram. The second half of the book (11:27–50:26) focuses on the history of the patriarchs. In this section, Jacob returns to Bethel and receives a renewed blessing from the God who had abundantly kept his promise to be with him.

Content: Hearing the Text

Read Genesis 35:1–35:29 together out loud.

Credo: Believing the Truth

Following the disastrous affair at Shechem, God spoke to Jacob once more, commanding him to return to the place where God had appeared to him at the beginning of his wanderings—to go up to build an altar at Bethel. When Jacob obeyed, God provided him with supernatural protection from the Canaanites who terrified him. Upon his arrival, God blessed him once more, confirming past promises and adding new ones. Though Jacob's struggles were far from over, neither failure nor suffering would ever be able to thwart the unstoppable love of the God who works even the worst of things together for good.

Conduct: Reshaping Our Walk

After the disaster at Shechem, God called Jacob to return to Bethel and reminded him of the ways in which he had delivered him in the past. What are some of the ways in which God has delivered you over the course of your walk with him?

Examples: Enabling you to serve him in ways that you never thought possible; Delivering you out of situations in which faithfulness seemed impossible, etc.

Though Rachel was convinced she would die if she did not have children, in reality she was to die because she did. In our own lives, what are some things that we are convinced we cannot live without, even though God has not yet given them to us?

Examples: A spouse; the job that we desire; the house that we desire, etc.
