# TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

## Genesis 39:21–40:23

### *Context: Setting the Table*

The second half of Genesis (11:27–50:26) has five sections of alternating length. The first, from 11:27–25:11, provides the “generations of Terah,” focusing on the story of Abraham. The brief second section (25:12–18) provides the generations of the passed-over line of Ishmael. The third section (25:19–35:29) provides the “generations of Isaac,” focusing on the story of Jacob. The brief fourth section (36:1–37:1) provides the generations of the passed-over line of Esau. The fifth and final section (37:2–50:26) provides the “generations of Jacob,” focusing on the stories of Joseph and Judah. In our text this week, God continues to be with Joseph, even after his unjust enslavement and imprisonment, enabling him to interpret the dreams of his fellow prisoners.

### *Content: Hearing the Text*

Read Genesis 39:21–40:23 together out loud.

### *Credo: Believing the Truth*

Despite the injustices that Joseph experienced from others, God continued to be with him. Though God’s blessing on his diligent labors may have seemed at the time to be of benefit to everyone but Joseph himself, he was in reality being prepared to rule all of Egypt, to be in the right place at the right time to preserve the family from whom would come the promised Redeemer. When done unto the Lord, faithful labor is never in vain, no matter how futile it may seem in the present!

### *Conduct: Reshaping Our Walk*

Though the Lord made everything which Joseph did to prosper, this prosperity initially only benefited others. How might we be tempted to overlook the Lord’s blessing on our own lives because the benefit of that blessing is being received by others?

*Examples:* Skill and talent that always seems to end up being used for the benefit of others; the blessings that flow through faithful homemakers to their families, etc.

What are some of the ways in which we might be tempted to bitterness when, in the process of preparation, God sees fit to allow others to overlook us?

*Examples:* A seemingly endless wait for a spouse; Frustration when others, perhaps less deserving than ourselves, are given positions of influence and we are ignored once again, etc.
