# TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

## Exodus 38–40

### *Observation (38:2):*

When the KJV was translated, the modern distinction in English usage between brass (normally an alloy of copper and zinc) and bronze (normally an alloy of copper and tin) had not yet come into common use (OED). The underlying Hebrew word refers either to unalloyed copper or to what we would now refer to as bronze.

### *Application (38–40):*

The sheer level of detail devoted to the construction of the tabernacle demonstrates the great seriousness with which God takes every aspect of approaching him in worship. How might we be tempted to treat the worship of Almighty God in a flippant fashion?

*Examples:* Scrolling through social media during private devotions or public worship; referring to God using slang or even sacrilegious language, etc.

### *Application (38–40):*

Sixteen times in these three chapters alone we find the phrase “as the Lord commanded Moses.” How might we be tempted, even without being flippant, to decide for ourselves how to “worship” the Lord, while ignoring the clear instructions found in both the Old and New Testaments?

*Examples:* Viewing worship as a performance that must be adapted to our music preferences (whatever those may be!); ignoring the humbling of ourselves that is at the heart of all biblical worship, etc.

## Matthew 27:32–66

### *Application (27:39):*

As he hung naked and bleeding on the cross, Jesus wasn’t praised as a noble Savior but rather mocked as a reject and a failure. How might we be tempted to avoid the shame of the cross that he so openly endured for us?

*Examples:* Refusing to confess the secret sins that he paid for openly; staying silent when we have opportunities to witness, etc.
