

RESPONSE TO COVID-19

As the body of Christ in Bremerton, our church is called to be an embassy for the kingdom of God. In the midst of the panic that is gripping our society, we are called to live out a hope that cannot be shaken by the spread of any virus, to display a peace that cannot be taken away by any financial downturn, and to refuse to allow our mission to be placed on hold by any disaster.

As the pastors of the church, recognizing that we cannot and must not panic as those who have no hope, we must also refuse to foolishly ignore real danger. This is far easier said than done. We have given many hours to prayerful discussion as to what our continued response to the ongoing threat of COVID-19 should look like. While we recognize that no solution is perfect, we have agreed on the following:

1. We will continue to gather for worship on Sunday Mornings.
2. Our Neighborhood Fellowships, with the precautions noted below, will meet at the discretion of their leaders on a case by case basis.
3. We will limit our corporate gatherings to Sunday morning only for the next few weeks.
4. We are asking that you do not attend if you are coughing, experiencing shortness of breath, or have a fever over 100.4. We recommend that you consider staying home if you are at greater risk of infection as a result of heart disease, lung disease, diabetes, or a compromised immune system. We would also recommend that you consider staying home if you are over 60 years old, especially if you have other health conditions. We are asking that you not shake hands at church and that everyone wash their hands frequently.

We will continue to monitor the situation and keep you updated regarding any additional precautions that become necessary. Let's continue to pray for one another to be the salt and light that all of us have been called to be!

TOGETHER IN SCRIPTURE

Numbers 35-36

Observation (35:8):

The fundamental principle of proportional giving for the support of the worship of the Lord taught here is explicitly repeated in the New Testament (1 Corinthians 16:2).

Application (35:15):

Just as the cities of refuge were for the use of citizens (Jews) and immigrants (Gentiles) alike, so also Jesus, our City of Refuge, offers salvation to those of every tribe and tongue in every corner of the world. How could each of us become more intentional about fulfilling this great commission that we have been entrusted with?

Luke 3

Observation (3:21-22):

At the baptism of Jesus the incarnate Son was in the water, the Spirit was in the air, and the Father spoke from heaven. This clearly points to the individual reality of the three glorious persons who each entirely possess all of the fulness of the singular, undivided, and eternal Divine Nature. Though the mystery of the Holy Trinity is far beyond our comprehension it is the very foundation of our salvation!

Observation (3:23-38):

While the details are too complex to go into here, the most satisfactory reconciliation of the differences between the genealogy found here and the one found in Matthew's Gospel is that Matthew provides the legal genealogy of Joseph (including adoptions etc) while Luke provides his natural ancestry.

Application (3:10-14):

When John was asked about repentance, he told the people to be generous, the tax collectors to be honest, and the soldiers to be patient and gentle. Genuine repentance always involves a reversal of the core desires of our heart in the nitty gritty details of our individual every day lives. How might we be tempted to define repentance by the way that it ought to show up in other peoples lives instead of the way it ought to be transforming our own?





